To find a grave location three things are needed.

Go to NAMES INDEX and scroll to find the name of the deceased and write down the data from the last three columns. Example: section I, row L, lot 7

There are three sections: I, II, and III. In section I the rows are labeled A through R. In section II the rows are labeled A through P. In section III the rows are labeled A through Q.

Go to PLAT INDEX and using the section number and the row letter, determine a page number for that section which contains the location. (section I, page 3 - as from the example above)

Go to the CEMETERY GRAVE MAP and find your section/page number (at bottom of page). From the above example follow the row (L) down to lot (7) for the location of the grave site.
